

Vow Examples

The vows are the most magical part of a wedding ceremony. There are numerous options of how they are done, and usually take one of following forms:

- Recited statements and promises (each of you read your own vows)
- Repeated lines (each of you take it in turns to repeat the lines offered by the celebrant)
- Questions and response (simplest options that requires only an 'I do' from you both)

Here are a few examples to consider and get your creative juices running if you wish to write your own.

"[Name], do you take [name] to be your lawful wedded wife/husband?" [Each responds, "I do."] "Do you promise to love and cherish [her/him], in sickness and in health, for richer for poorer, for better for worse, and forsaking all others, keep yourself only unto her/him, for so long as you both shall live?" [Each responds, "I do."] "Do you together promise in the presence of your friends and family that you will at all times and in all circumstances, conduct yourselves toward one another as becomes husband and wife?" [Together they respond, "We do."] "Do you together promise you will love, cherish and respect one another throughout the years?" [Together they respond, "We do."]

I, [name], take you [name], to be my [husband/wife], to have and to hold from this day forward, for better or for worse, for richer, for poorer, in sickness and in health, to love and to cherish; until death do us part.

I [name], take you [name], to be my [husband/wife], my partner in life and my one true love. I will cherish our union and love you more each day than I did the day before. I will trust you and respect you, laugh with you and cry with you, loving you faithfully through good times and bad, regardless of the obstacles we may face together. I give you my hand, my heart, and my love, from this day forward for as long as we both shall live.
